- "Frederick Mote has suggested that the Chinese may be "unique in having no creation myth," and Mote reminds us of Hu Shih's observation "that centuries of Christian missionaries had been frustrated and chagrined by the apparent inability of Chinese to take sin seriously. For in the Chinese, organically conceived world; there can be no parts wrongfully present... The question of man's immortality in a future that "really counts" -- if he is lucky enough or good enough to transcend the material present reality -- does not even arise. This being true in the Great Tradition, countertendencies in the popular religion in China's highly congruent culture were correspondingly weakened.

Yet there are creation myths as part of a rich cosmogeny. Some illustrations demonstrate how they fit into the pattern of creation his developed in other worldviews." **Chinese Worldview Expressions**
